



121 LifeGroups On Mission Options

The goal for every LifeGroup to be partnered in a local or global mission effort carries a great potential impact for God's Kingdom through 121, and there are many ways a group can be involved.

If your LifeGroup has unique limitations and needs to be involved in something that is integrated into your regular weekly meeting time...

- Contact Rodney Howell to establish a focus on one of 121's global partnerships (Honduras, Russia, India, Cambodia). He will arrange for a group orientation and ongoing ways for your group to pray and be involved on a weekly basis, integrated into the normal, weekly flow of your LifeGroup.
- Similar relationships can be established with local partnerships, where the group prays each week and occasionally can be involved hands-on in a ministry project. Contact Amy Nobles for opportunities.
- *Example: Honduras – receive regular updates, pray for specific partners and needs each week, invite a 121er who just returned from Honduras, send supplies and needed items...*

If your LifeGroup will commit to serve regularly on Saturdays or a certain day or night of the week...

- Mission Arlington, GRACE, and other opportunities are available for the LifeGroup that would like to partner with an organization and serve together on a consistent basis, building relationships or expertise that would be valuable to a particular ministry.
- *Example: Serve together with Mission Arlington on a Saturday every six weeks, building into the same community of people or helping with a certain ongoing ministry need.*

If your LifeGroup will regularly dedicate the regular LifeGroup meeting time to be involved in a mission effort...

- Contact Amy Nobles for opportunities to serve regularly in a local partnership for a particular time window. There are also ways you can dedicate LifeGroup time on a regular basis to a global partnership. Contact Rodney Howell for those options and ideas.
- *Example: Serve one Monday night each month with La Comunidad.*

If your LifeGroup can meet on different days some weeks or work with greater flexibility...

- Some of our local partnerships are simultaneously very demanding and very rewarding. *For example, adopting a refugee family or an international student* are “high sacrifice, high reward” opportunities.
- A LifeGroup ready for this challenge will be willing to change the regular meeting time of the group, letting the mission effort drive the schedule.
